## Office of the Archbishop March 2, 2022

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,  
We are all aware that Vladimir Putin, leader of Russia,  
has resorted to the madness of war by his unprovoked  
invasion of Ukraine. The news from Ukraine is  
heartbreaking and infuriating.**

**At the same time, we have been impressed by the  
courage of the Ukrainian people who are defending  
their homeland against the invaders. As individuals, we  
feel that there is little we can do. As one commentator  
said, we are spectators to a war.**

**However, we can offer humanitarian aid through those  
who are able to assist the people of Ukraine. For this  
reason, I am asking that there be a collection in every  
parish in the Archdiocese of Mobile as soon as possible  
to help with humanitarian aid to the Ukrainian people.  
This money will be sent to Archbishop Borys Gudziak,  
Archbishop of Philadelphia for Ukrainians. He is the  
lead bishop for all Ukrainian Catholics in the United  
States and has appealed for help to assist with  
humanitarian aid. I ask for your generosity.**

**Pray fervently that Our Mother Mary will pray with us.  
That God will protect the people of Ukraine and will  
guide the leaders of the nations to turn from war and  
build peace.**

**May God bless you and may God bless the Ukrainian  
people.**
