## Anointing Of The Sick

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age.

## To supporters of Suzette's Food Pantry

**We wanted to let you know of some changes. First of all – THANK YOU for your continued support in feeding our neighbors in Semmes and Wilmer. Over 200 families receive food here every month. In the aftermath of covid, we now distribute food bags twice a month. The bags are put together on the first and third Tuesdays and distributed on the first and third Thursdays. We also go to Feeding the Gulf Coast in Theodore once a month to buy and pick up the food (2000-3000 pounds at a time).**

**As many of you know, Pat Grisso is leaving for Michigan to be with her family. Pat is the only official member of St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP) Society. It requires officers and twice monthly meetings. None of the volunteers are able to join the organization – but want to continue as volunteers with the Pantry. So we are putting membership in the SVdP Society on hold until parishioners in the future want to reinstate it. Our church will continue Suzette's Food Pantry – and if you donate online, that is how it is now listed. Any donations will continue to be part of your yearly tax statement. Again – THANK YOU for supporting this ministry.**
