

Sunday trivia: ALL ABOUT BISHOPS.....

1- What is minimum age limit to become a bishop in the Catholic church?

2- Do the bishops and priests really become the person of Christ?

3- What special tools does a bishop have at his disposal?

BONUS: How many bishops and Archbishops has Mobile had since the city was settled?

Answers:

1- A man must be at least 35 years old and have been a priest for at least 5 years to be appointed bishop by the pope. And a bishop must submit to the Vatican formal resignation papers when he turns 75 years old. (Canon Law 401 of the 1983 Code of Canon Law)

2- **YES!!!** “From him [Jesus Christ], bishops and priests receive the mission and faculty (“the sacred power”) to act “in persona Christi Capitis...” (ccc 875)

3-**The Crozier**-(Pastoral Staff resembling a shepherd’s crook-because he is the shepherd of his flock).

The Mitre-(A pointed liturgical headdress worn by bishops during formal occasions, representing authority and spiritual leadership, the two peaks represent the Old and New Testaments).

The Zucchetto-(A purple skullcap worn underneath the mitre, developed to cover the tonsure, a shaved spot on the head).

The Pectoral Cross-(a cross worn on the chest, signifying the bishop’s dignity and office that he wears close to the heart, reflecting the bishop’s role in guiding their flock towards salvation.

BONUS– Since 1829 Mobile has had; 10-Bishops; and 3-Archbishops; the most newly appointed is Most Reverend Archbishop Mark Rivituso who will be installed officially on September 3, 2025 during the 1100 a.m. mass at the Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception.
