

Anointing Of The Sick

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage .

We no longer take Medical Equipment. Thank you.






Lori and Daniel Smalling and Rose and Van Milne delivered Christmas gifts to the seniors at AHEPA. The residents were excited and appreciative.
