Trivia– PENTECOST

- 1– What is Pentecost?
- 2– Can the Holy Spirit move within us like with the Apostles on Pentecost?
- 3–Can the Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity help us to pray?

Bonus: "God is love" and love is his first gift, containing all others. "God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us." (CCC733)

3–"The Spirit helps us in our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with sighs too deep for words." The Holy Spirit, the artisan of God's works, is the master of prayer. (CCC741)

2–"The Spirit prepares men and goes out to them with his grace, in order to draw them, to bring them into communion with God, that they may "bear much fruit." (CCC732)

He makes present the mystery of Christ, supremely in the Eucharist, in order to reconcile and opens their minds to the understanding of his Death and Resurrection. He makes them to Christ. The Spirit manifests the risen Lord to them, recalls his word to them and communiates a divine person: of his fullness, Christ the Lord, pours out the Spirit in abundance." (CCC731)
